Dimitris Kamouzis is a Researcher at the Centre for Asia Minor Studies (Athens, Greece). He received his PhD in history at King's College London with a thesis on the Greek Orthodox minority of Istanbul (mid-19th century to 1930). He has written several articles on the Greek Orthodox populations of the Ottoman Empire/Turkey and is co-editor of the collective volume *State-Nationalisms in the Ottoman Empire*, *Greece and Turkey: Orthodox and Muslims*, 1830-1945 (2013).
