Prof. George Th. Mavrogordatos studied Politics, Economics, and Law at the University of Athens, and holds a Ph.D. in Political Science from the University of California, Berkeley. For thirty years (1982-2012) he taught Modern History, Comparative Politics, and Political Sociology at the University of Athens, including courses on the American political system and on Athenian democracy. His books include *Stillborn Republic*, for which he received the Woodrow Wilson Foundation Award of the American Political Science Association in 1984.
